For the following infectious diseases that children commonly contract at nurseries, please refer to the recommended guidelines for attendance, follow the diagnosis of your regular physician, and submit this notice upon attendance. Please ensure your child has fully recovered and is fit for group activities before returning to the nursery.

Infectious Diseases	Attendance Guidelines
Scarlet Fever	After 24-48 hours of Antibiotic treatment
Mycoplasma Pneumonia	When fever and sever cough has subsided
Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease	Without fever or month blisters/ulcers affecting regular eating habits
Roseola	When overall condition is good
Viral Gastroenteritis	After fever relief and when voting and diarrhea have stopped, and regular meals can be consumed.
Herpangina	After fever relief, disappearance of respiratory symptoms, and when overall condition is good. -
Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Infection	After fever relief, disappearance of respiratory symptoms, and when overall condition is good
Shingles	After all rashes have scabbled over.
Exanthema subitem (Roseola Infantum)	After fever relief, with good spirits and overall good condition.
